- Comm Coll Credits. Can apply 64 credit hours from a two-year school toward the degree program.
- Resident Credits. To meet residency requirement, must have at least 15 credits for an Associate's degree and 30 earned hours for a Bachelor's degree with SLU.
- Major. Shows total hours needed in major, how many hours applied, and how many remaining.
- Resident Major. At least 15 of the 30 resident hours must be in the major.
- Minor (optional). Two courses from the major may count toward the minor and you may use transfer courses to fill half the requirements.
- Total Credits. Shows total hours required for this degree program. Earned hours are total hours earned from all methods, regardless of academic program; i.e., institution credit, transfer credit, and non-coursework credit.
- Cumulative GPA. You must meet the minimum Cumulative and Major GPA (see Major section) in order to graduate.
- Program Status. Shows status of Program, either In Progress, Pending when registered for the final class, or Completed.
